CONSULTANCY OVERVIEW

We are seeking a skilled writer to produce narrative impact articles and scripts for short videos. This person has a knack for translating technical achievements into approachable, friendly copy without compromising depth or accuracy. They are meticulous with facts, write clear copy, and know how to weave a compelling narrative whether for a web article or video.

- For articles, the consultancy will include utilizing existing interviews as well as conducting new interviews were needed
- For video scripts, the consultancy will utilize existing footage filmed across countries in Africa and Asia. The writer will support post-production by developing scripts following the objectives of a brief.

This work falls under Nutrition International's Global Communications team. This person will be a valuable addition that will enhance and strengthen Nutrition International's suite of editorial content. Stories will focus on the areas of child survival, adolescent nutrition, maternal and newborn health and nutrition, and food fortification.

OBJECTIVES

The main objective is to produce stories that will be published on Nutrition International's website and distributed through social media. Working closely with the Manager, Storytelling, the writer will leverage the library of existing interviews to create compelling articles and script mini-documentaries (3-5mins). This content will strengthen our brand awareness and invite more people to become familiar with us and our work.

The writer will adhere to the Nutrition International Writing Style Guide (based on the Canadian Press Style Guide). All pieces will need to follow a quality review process.



SCOPE OF WORK

This will be a long-term, on-demand agreement. Stories will be assigned on a rolling basis with an expected cadence of 2-3 per month.

This position is remote-based and will be supporting Nutrition International's Global Communications team, which is based in Ottawa, Canada.


The consultant is expected to provide their technical expertise in a timely manner to fulfill storytelling needs upon request. Nutrition International will provide the writer with the following:
